

Topic title: VET4LEC project

Brief description and main aims:

In 2017 the EU sectoral social partners for the construction industry FIEC, representing the employers, and EFBWW (European Federation of Building and Wood Workers), representing the workers, started a project, co-financed by the European Commission, entitled "VET4LEC", which stands for : Vocational Education and Training for Low Energy Construction.

Why FIEC is dealing with this issue/topic and their objective(s):

Based on the information collected in the 10 participating countries (Belgium, Bulgaria, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Poland, Slovenia, Spain), the main aims of the project were to: evaluate different approaches to developing and delivering vocational education and training for low energy construction; provide criteria for curricula development and outline components of a core energy literacy curriculum compatible with the European policy tools; develop guidelines and recommendations on how to address the weaknesses identified.
